

Academic Arts Academy Annual Art Day

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Art Day? All AAA students spend the entire day submerged in Art. The day begins with an opening performance attended by all AAA students. During the day they attend four 55 minutes sessions taught by local artists. We have 21 simultaneous sessions so that class sizes are kept between 15-17 students. The day ends with another whole group session of a performance and a sharing of projects worked on by multiple sessions.

When is Art Day this year? Friday, May 3rd

What is the format of the classes? There are four, 55min session taught by each teaching artist with a break for lunch which is provided by the school. Most sessions consist of the artist sharing their journey on how they became an artist and what it is like to work in their field. This sharing is followed by a hands on activity for the students. If the activity is longer, the sharing can be done while the students work.

What about supplies? The Art Day coordinator will contact all artists to get a list of supplies and facility requirements for the session.
